

DGPF Annual Conference – Darmstadt, March 25-27, 2026

Call for Papers

The **46th Scientific-Technical Annual Conference** of the German Society for Photogrammetry, Remote Sensing, and Geoinformation (DGPF) will take place from **March 25 to 27, 2026, in Darmstadt**. It will be organized locally by the Remote Sensing and Image Analysis division of TU Darmstadt.

Preceding the conference, there will be an event organized by the DGPF Young Professionals Network on **March 25, 2025**, and a Summer School jointly organized with the Polish Society for Photogrammetry and Remote Sensing (PTFiT) on **March 23 and 24, 2025**.

Scientists, developers, and users in photogrammetry, remote sensing, and geoinformatics are invited to submit contributions for the conference, initially in the form of **abstracts**. Upon acceptance of the abstract, a **full paper** (5-12 pages) should be submitted for the conference proceedings. The proceedings will be published online, and all contributions will receive a DOI after the conference.

All submissions will undergo a review process.

The **abstract** for a presentation/poster submission should be a maximum of **500 words**. It should describe (i) motivation/problem statement, (ii) method/investigation, and (iii) results.

Poster submissions are explicitly encouraged. Please indicate at the time of submission whether the contribution is desired as a poster or a long presentation. Each poster will also be presented in an approximately 6-minute short talk.

The two best contributions in the conference proceedings will be awarded the **Photogrammetry Prize** and the **Remote Sensing Prize** by the Nico Rüpke Foundation Hamburg, respectively. Each prize is endowed with **1000 EUR** and also includes travel expense assistance.
